Serving During the Pandemic

The COVID19 shutdown of schools and businesses gave us new opportunities to serve the families in Lago Vista. Our Program Director, Jonah Kunisch, led our young program staff in a sack lunch distribution twice a week, thanks to our partnership with the Larimer Food Bank and KidsPak. They handed out about 2000 lunches, 1000 snacks, and 100 KidsPaks in 2 months. The Thompson School District also provided learning packets, books, and school supplies that we made available to the families doing their schoolwork at home.

We were able to continue our youth leadership training programs and youth group virtually. This enabled the staff and youth to stay in touch with each other, learn together, and share the joys and struggles of “shelter at home.”
